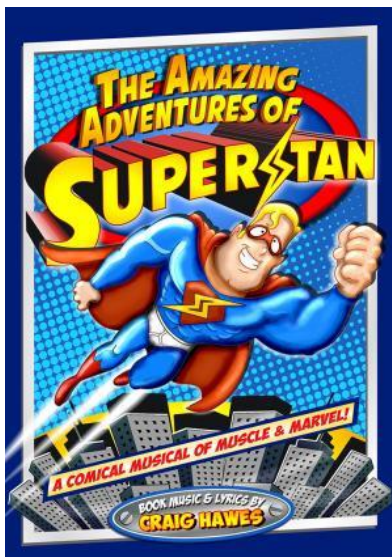

Please remember there are no clubs next week.



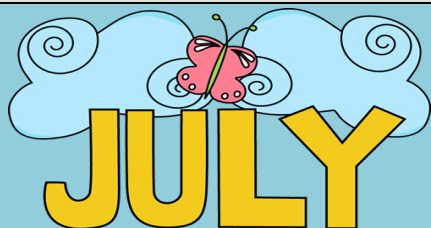
Bikes/scooters
