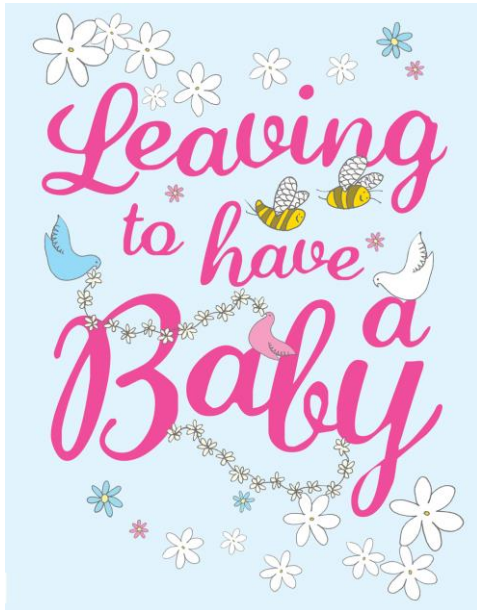

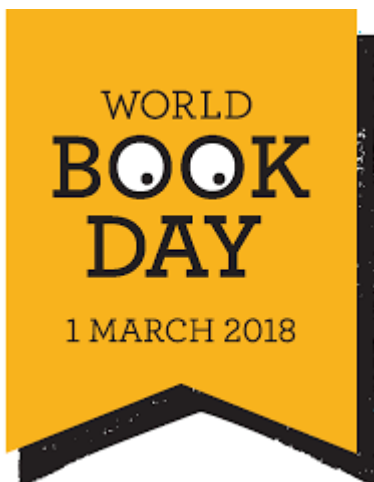
Fundraise while you shop and best of all it's free

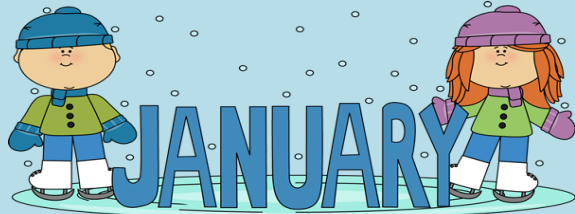

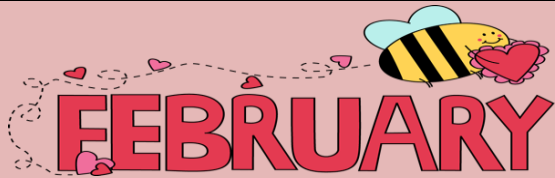
