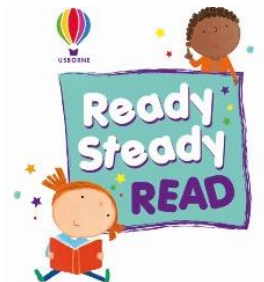

If your child/ren would like to take part please bring in your decorated egg the week beginning Monday 26th March (please name).

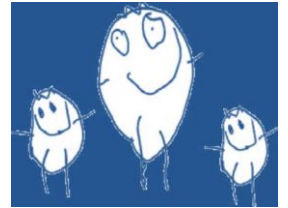
