We hope you all had a restful half term and welcome back for Spring Term 2026!

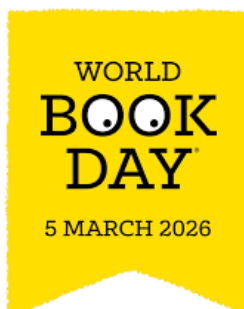
Attendance

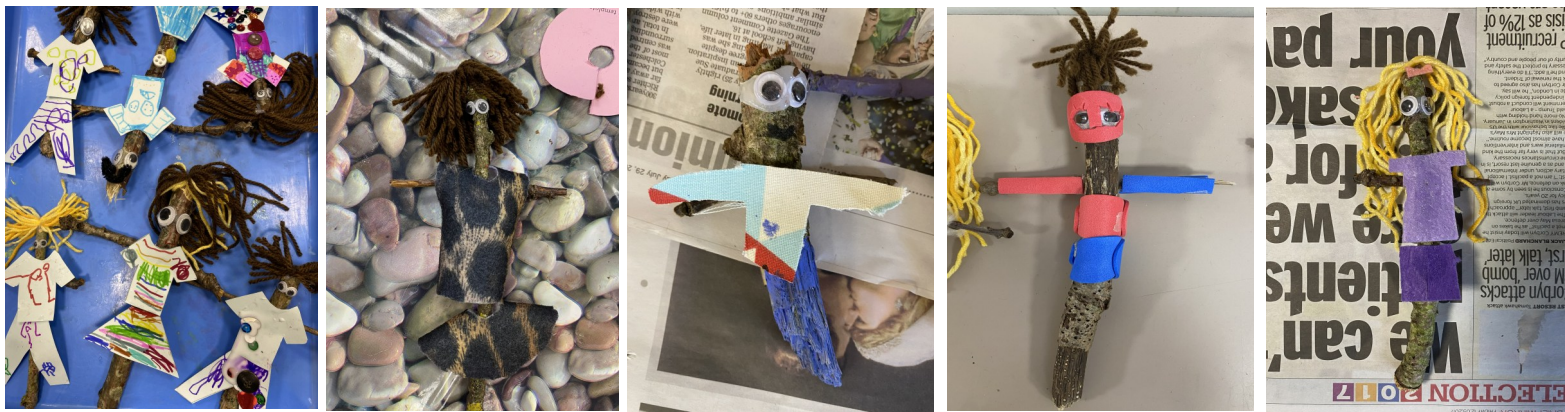
