Subject Intent

Our Expressive Art and Design curriculum aims to inspire and equip our learners to think critically and creatively and to acquire new skills that will enable them to bring their own creative visions to life. In addition, we intend to promote a knowledge and appreciation of music and art in the world around them and to gain an awareness of the many different styles and forms it can take. Effective continuous provision will ensure that there is always opportunity for children to practise, apply and refine new skill and to interpret art and construction resources openly and creatively. Through open ended role-play and small world resources, children will be encouraged to create their own narratives using vocabulary that is influenced by books.
